HISTORY

Steeped in tradition, the Hotel Monte Rosa was the first hotel in the Matterhorn village. The hotel opened in 1839 by the local doctor, it was at the time the only village inn, boasted three rooms and was taken over by the Seiler family in 1853. Its guests include Edward Whymper, the first conqueror of the Matterhorn, and numerous other mountaineers. Over the years the hotel has been extended and refurbished on several occasions.

It was upgraded to meet the demanding standards currently expected of an international hotel, yet without losing the homely atmosphere and charm of a traditional turn-of-the-century alpine hotel. This is reflected in the various lounges and salons, the historical restaurant, one of the most beautiful in the Alps, and Edward's Gastro Bar.

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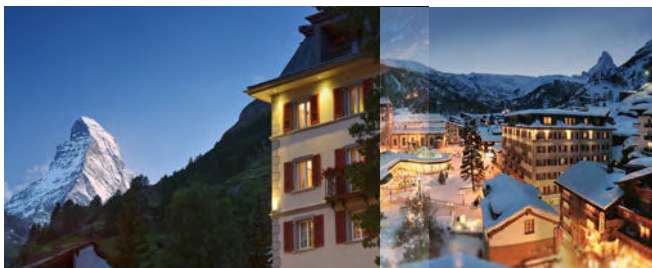

WHYMPER STUBE

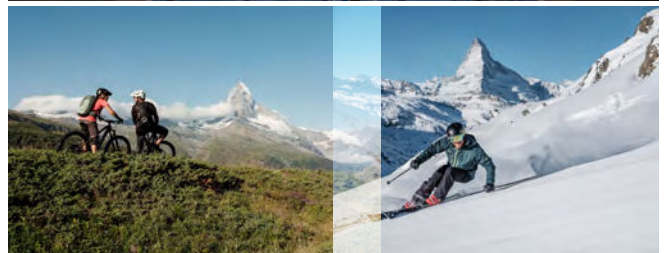
A rustic restaurant celebrating authentic, traditional Swiss dishes.

ARRIVING & PARKING

Zermatt is car free. Access for cars is only permitted as far as Täsch (5 km from Zermatt). Our "Welcome Parking" is located at the entrance of the village of Täsch. Our staff will take care of the luggage and organize the transfer to the hotel. Parking reservation through the hotel or directly.

Arrival by trains, taxi or helicopter. Distance to airport:

- Zurich: 3,5 hours by train / 4 hours by car
- Geneva: 4 hours by train / 3,5 hours by car
- Milano Malpensa: 4 hours by train / 3,5 hours by car
